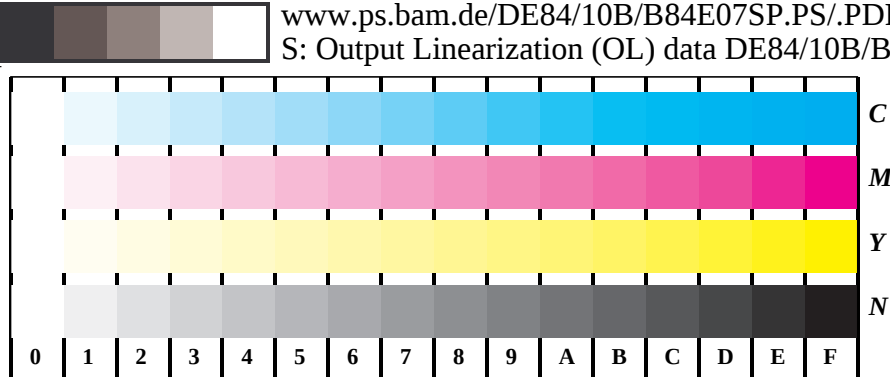
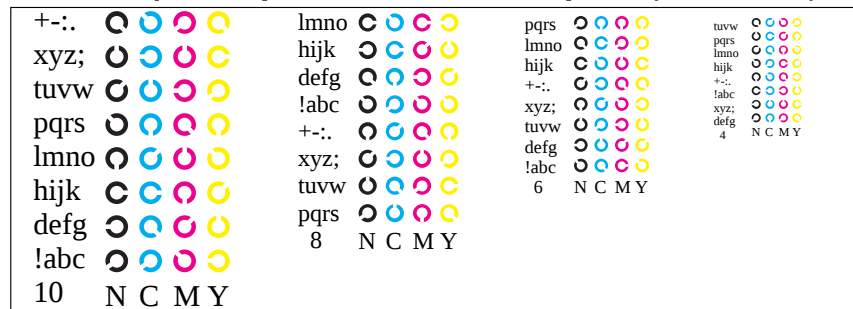


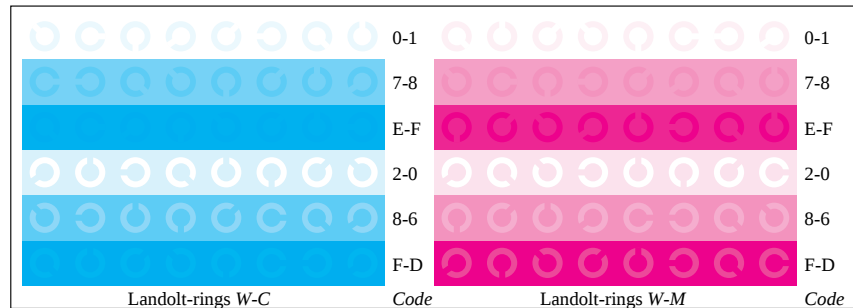

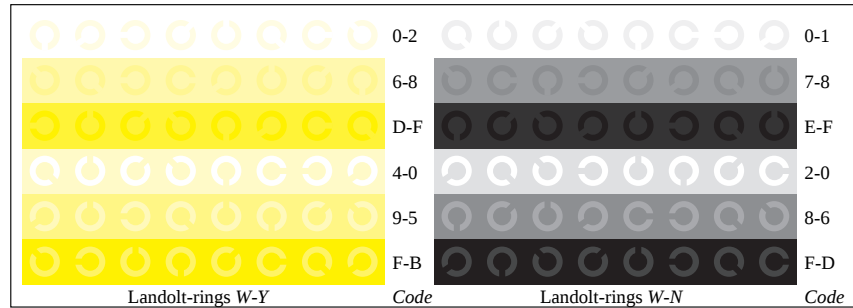
Picture B4: 16 equidistant steps W-C, W-M, W-Y and W-N; PS operator $cmv0^* / 000n^* setcmkcolor$

Picture B6: Landolt-rings W-C and W-M; Use of PS operator $cmv0^* / 000n^* setcmkcolor$

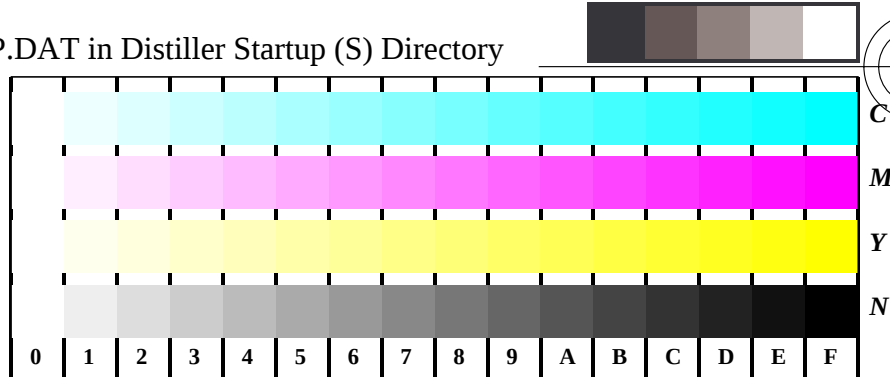


Picture B7: Landolt-rings W-Y and W-N; Use of PS operator $cmv0^* / 000n^* setcmkcolor$

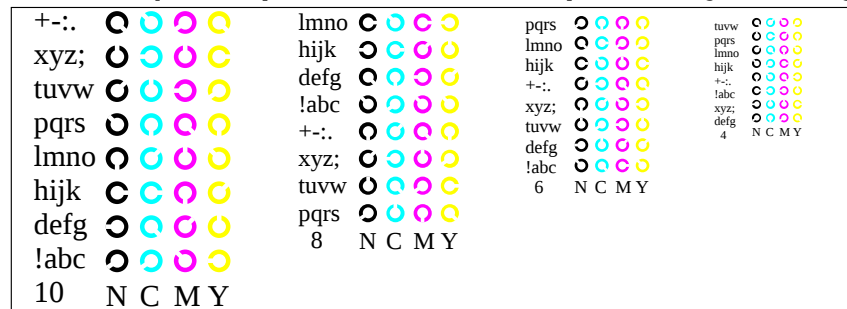

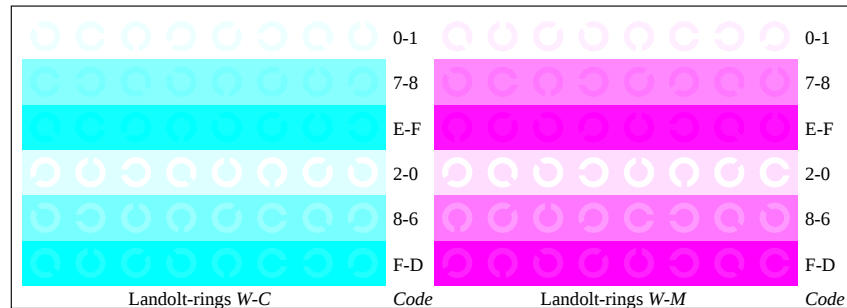

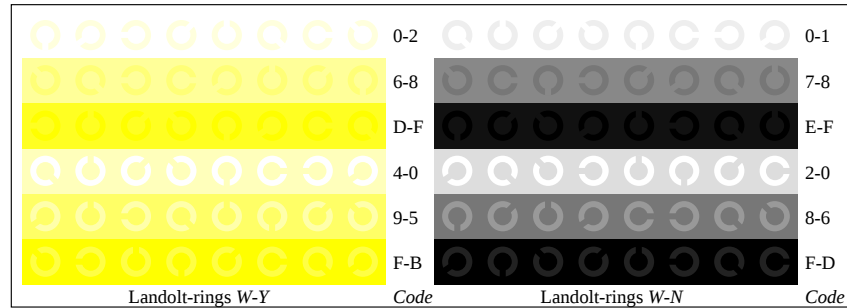
Picture B4: 16 equidistant steps W-C, W-M, W-Y and W-N; PS operator $olv^* setrgbcolor / w^* setgray$
