Advantages of Output Linearization:

- Linear relation between rgb and CIELAB data.
- No loss of visual information for 16 step colour series on different colour devices.
- Grey is printed by black only and not by CMY (complete under colour removal), low cost.

User visual test

with output of DIN 33872-X test charts.

Agrees the output with the user wishes (Y/N)?

If No (N) agreement to the user wishes then:

Output of reference test chart with 1080 colours.

Continues colour change in output (Y/N)?
